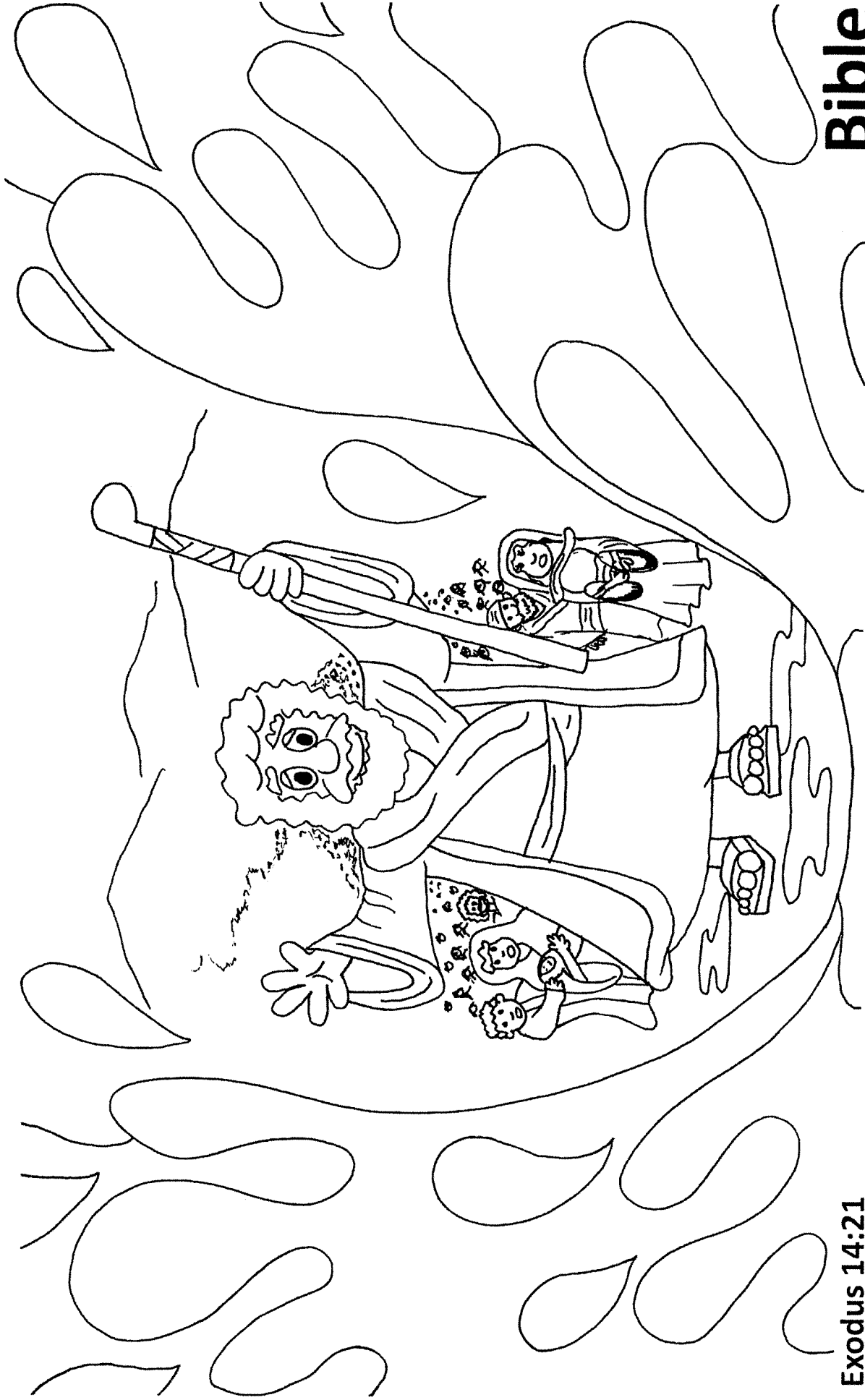

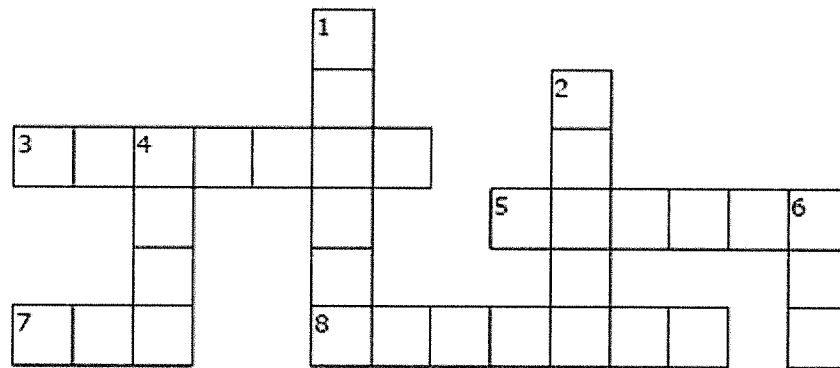
Exodus 14:21

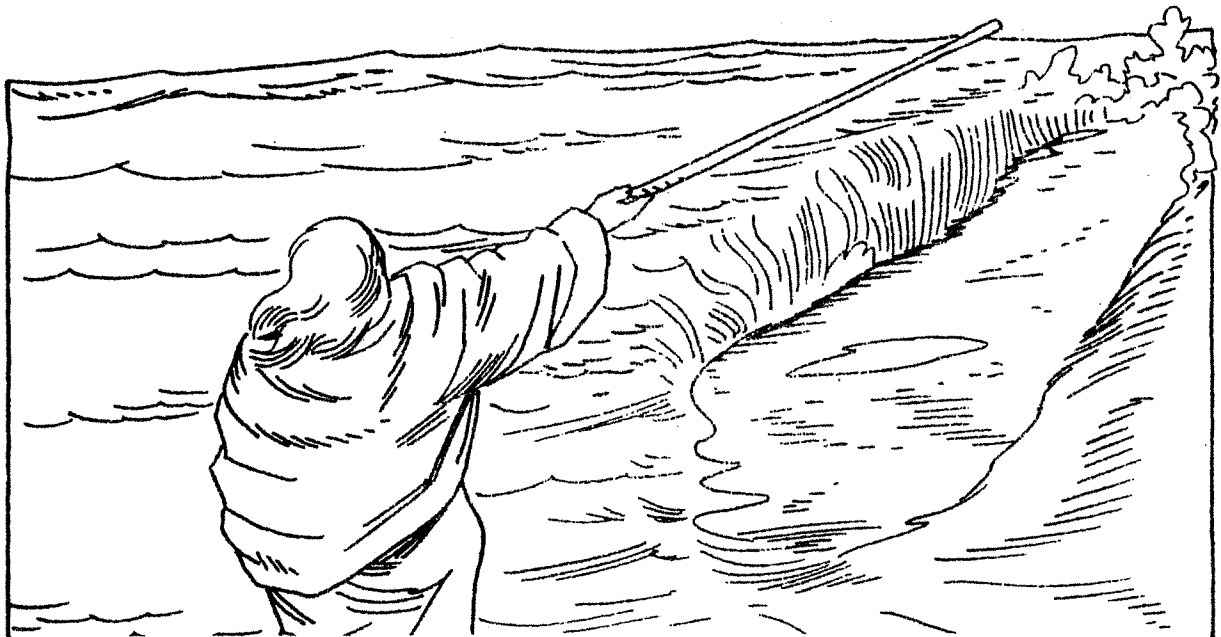

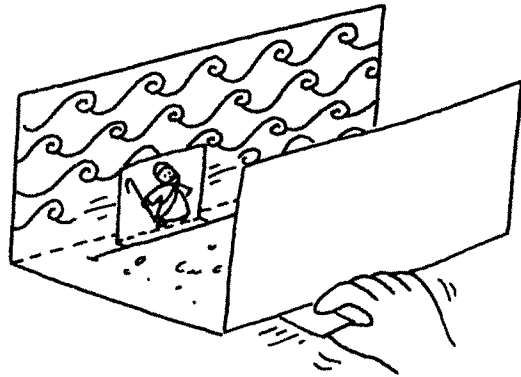
The Great Escape

God took care of Moses and led him to safety. The children will learn that God is here today to lead and guide them too. Children will get to help Moses and his people cross the Red Sea with this easy project.

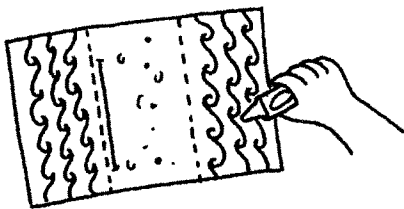
Materials Needed:

- * White construction paper or card stock
- * Markers or crayons
- * Scissors
- * Gluesticks
- * *Optional:* sand & glue

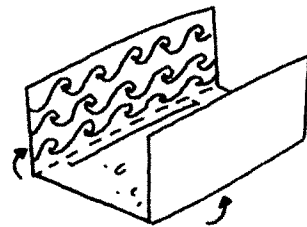


Directions:

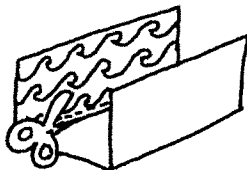
1. Copy the Red Sea pattern found on page 33 for each child in your group.
2. Color the water blue and the ground brown. A fun option, which will create a more realistic Red Sea, is to brush glue on the ground area and sprinkle with sand. Let dry.
3. Fold along the dotted lines so the water is lifted up on either side of the ground.
4. Cut along the line indicated next to the water of the Red Sea.
5. Make two copies of each of the character patterns found on pages 34–35.
6. Color and cut out the characters.
7. With the back sides together, glue like characters to each other and fold along the dotted line.
8. Slide the character into the slit until character is standing on dry land.
9. Move/slide the character “across the Red Sea.”



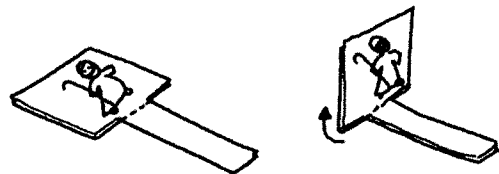
2. Color the water blue and the ground brown or sprinkle with sand.



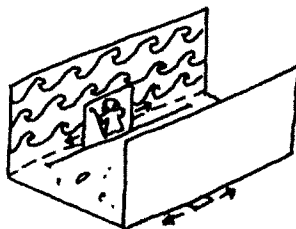
3. Fold on dotted lines and lift sides.



4. Cut a line to slide the characters.

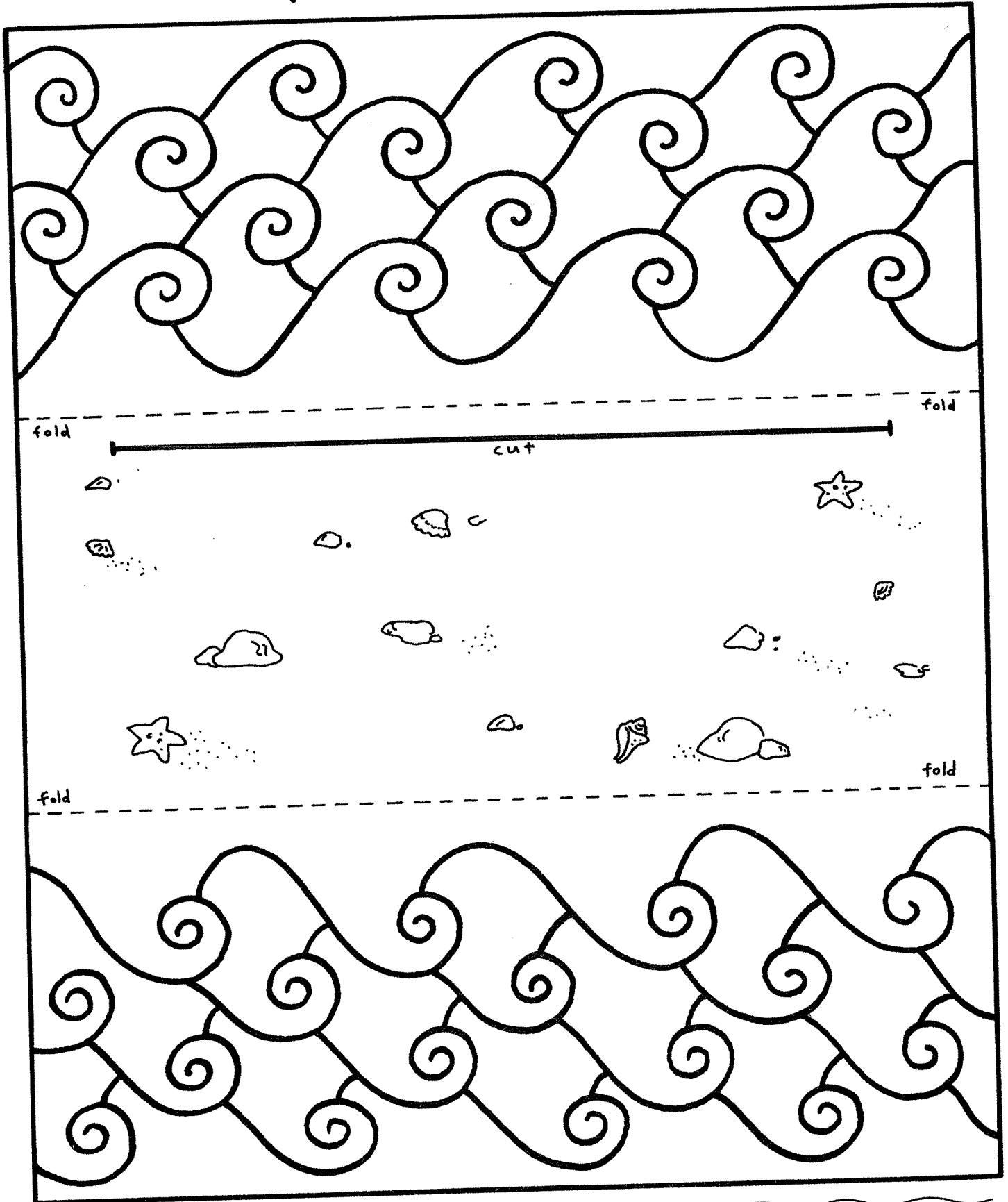


7. Glue like characters to each other and fold on the dotted line.



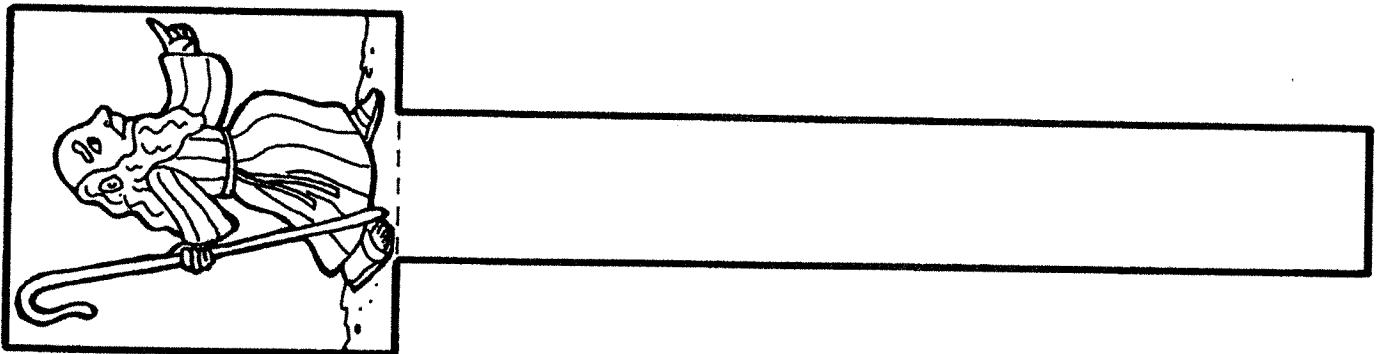
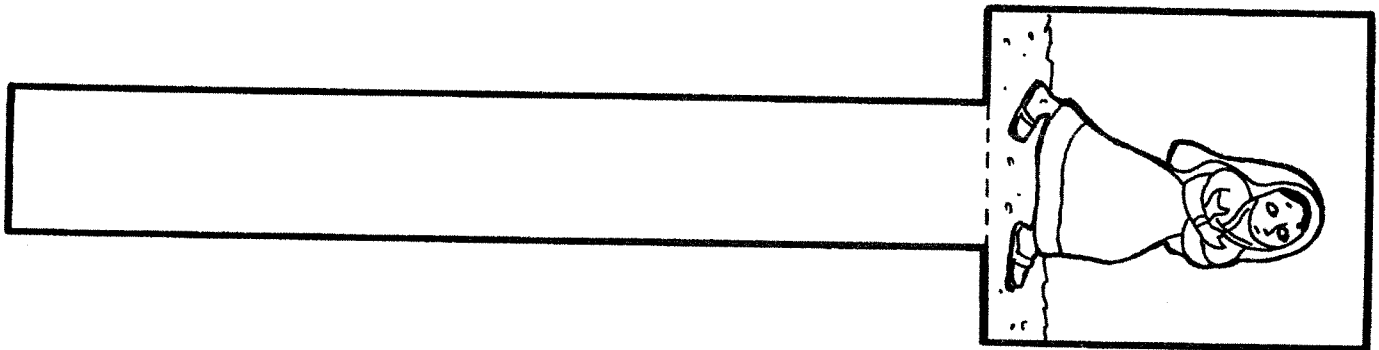
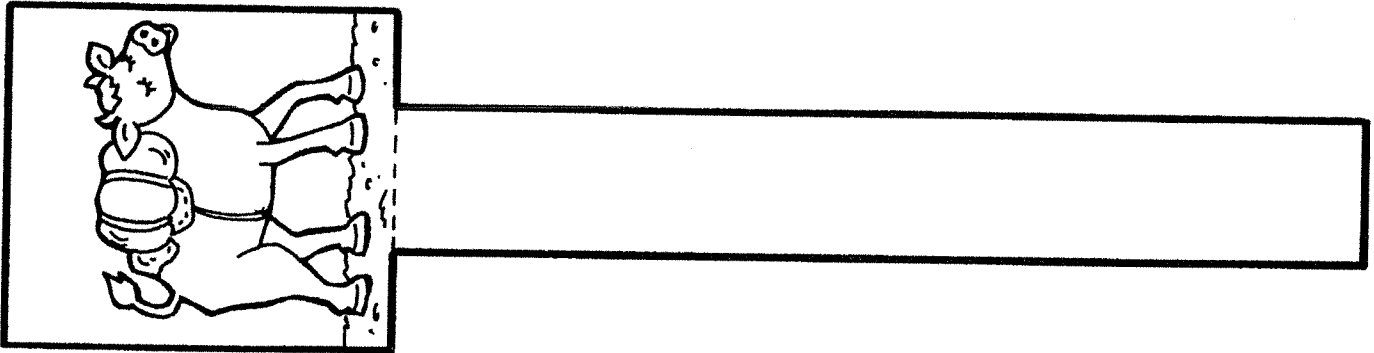
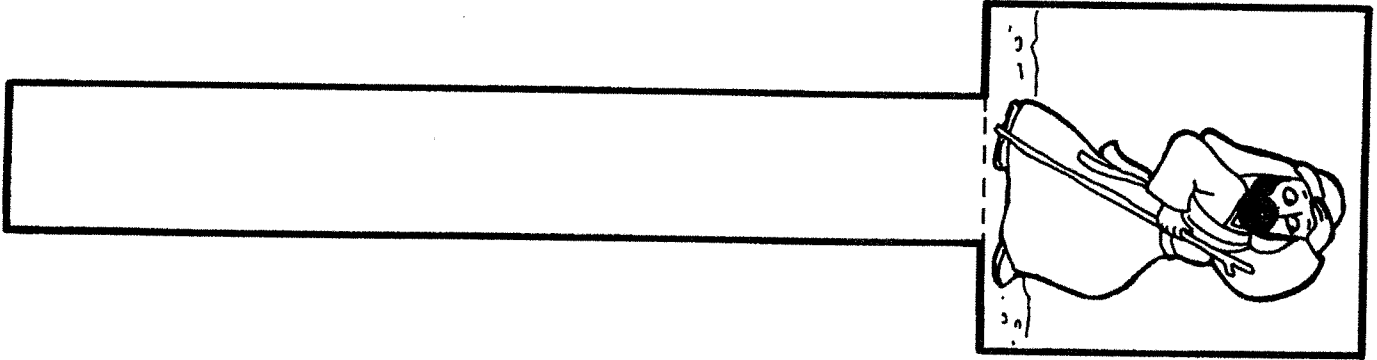
